Jesus Teaches

tips/schedule

This is a recommended schedule. You can adjust, but do make time for the lesson and the activity!

15 minutes	Check-in and play time
5 minutes	Clean-up toys
5 minutes	Lesson/story time
10 minutes	Prayer and snack
10 minutes	Lesson activity/craft
5 minutes	Song time
10 minutes	Play and clean-up time

LESSON TITLE

Jesus teaches on a mountain

OBJECTIVE

Kids will learn how God always takes care of us through The Sermon on the Mount.

BIBLE STORY

Read: "Jesus Teaches on a Mountain" (pages 318-322) in the Beginner's Bible.

God cares for you. 1 Peter 5:7

leader PREP

In February, we're going to learn about the Sermon on the Mount. This is where Jesus spoke about how God feeds the birds and "clothes" the flowers in beautiful colors. God thinks we are even more important than birds and flowers - so if He takes care of those things - why wouldn't He take care of us?

The goal of our activities is to provide experiences to help the kids grasp the concept for the month.

ACTIVITY

- February 2-3, 2013 - February 16-17, 2013

Today we learned about how Jesus was a teacher. He told people that God takes care of birds and flowers so, of course, He takes care of us. Hold up the stuffed bird and ask, "Does God love this bird? YES! Who does He love more? ME!" Hold up the stuffed flower and ask "Does God love this flower? YES! Who does He love more? ME!"

Supplies needed: Dove coloring page, crayons

large group SCRIPT

SPECIAL notes

We're using "The Beginner's Bible" for all of our stories.

If you'd like to read another kid version of the story of the birth of Jesus, The Jesus Storybook Bible does a great job. "The Singer" is the title of the story, starting on page 228.

presenter TIPS

• Try to have the kids sit down at the tables for the story - no toys or snacks! Other volunteers can help you get the kids sitting down with chairs pushed in. They can also help redirect kids who are getting up.

• Feel free to pause, use voice inflections or voices - remember being animated helps them listen!

• You can ask questions during the story too!

SCRIPT

Hold up the Bible and ask, "Does anyone know what this is?" That's right! It's a Bible. And the Bible is a very special book because God gave it to us. And the best part... It's all true!

We're going to learn even more about Jesus today! We all remember Jesus as a baby - but Jesus grew up - just like you are growing up. And as He grew up, He became a great teacher!

Read: "Jesus Teaches on a Mountain" (pages 318-322). Wow - isn't that great? Jesus is making sure we know that God will ALWAYS take care of us!

QUESTIONS - have the kids repeat the answers with you Does God love birds? (Yes) Does God love flowers? (Yes) Does God love us even more than birds and flowers? (YES!)

Let's say thank you to God." Dear God, we're so happy that you will always take good care of us. We love you! Amen."
