

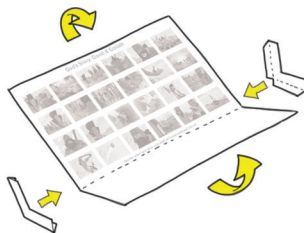

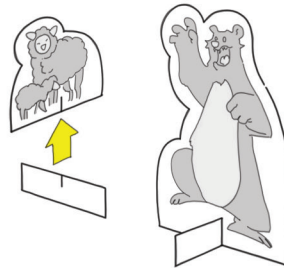
YOU CAN TELL GOD'S STORY...

STORYTELLING TIPS

1. Give each character a different voice.
2. Don't be afraid to *whisper* or **SHOUT!**
3. Make your own sound effects: growl, glug!
4. Use as much space as you need; the props don't have to fit in front of the background.
5. Bring your characters to life by describing what they smell, hear, taste, touch and see.
