


Cut out and bend the stage. Tape supports and place a book on the bottom to help keep the stage upright!




Ask an adult for help and cut out the stands and their characters. Almost done!



#### STORYTELLING TIPS

- 5. Bring your characters to life by describing what they smell, hear, taste, touch and see.
