


## THE PHILISTINES

A Philistine giant who was more than nine feet tall.



# Family Activities

#### **FAMILY REENACTMENT**

Time to get creative! We want to see how your family tells stories. First, visit crossroadskidsclub.net/slingshot to download, print and construct the diorama with background and characters. Then, record your reenactment of "David and Goliath". Finally, post the video to our Facebook page (facebook.com/crdschurchkc). You can see other families' videos there, too!

#### **GOD'S STORY: DAVID AND GOLIATH**

Watch the video of "David and Goliath" together (whichever version best fits your family). Then discuss these questions: (1) Where did David get the courage to know God would really help him beat Goliath? (2) Why did God defeat Goliath through a guy like David?



#### THE BIG RESCUE

Every story in the Bible points to the greatest story of all: Jesus' Rescue. Watch "God's Story: Easter" and "God's Story: Jesus' Rescue" (or read Luke 22-24). How does the way God rescued his family through David foreshadow the way God would rescue the world through Jesus?

#### DAVID DANCE PARTY

The Bible tells us a lot about David. Besides being a shepherd who killed Goliath, David loved to worship God by dancing (2 Samuel 6:14)! Check out the music videos for "One Rock One Shot" and "D-A-V-I-D." Make up your own choreography to bust a move David-style!





















You can read it in the book of I Samuel, chapter 17, in the Bible.

### Any particular Bible?

"The Jesus Storybook Bible" by Sally Lloyd-Jones and the "Adventure Bible" published by Zondervan are great resources. There are a wide variety of children's Bibles available. Check your local bookstore.

## What's the best way to read the Bible?

As with any book, the beginning is a great place to start. While the Bible is filled with a whole bunch of different stories, really it's one big story; God's story. It's filled with drama, excitement and—most of all—love. "The Jesus Storybook Bible" is a great Bible to read to help understand God's big story.

## I'm pretty new to the idea of God's story. How am I supposed to lead my kid?

Not having all the answers makes you human! It's okay to tell your child "I don't know" or "I don't understand, either". Being honest with your child and sharing what you know are great first steps to both of you developing deeper relationships with each other and Jesus. Plus, being honest opens up the opportunity for you to figure things out together.
