

This is a fun place to serve with a wide variety of ways to get involved. As a part of the team, you'll have the opportunity to have an impact on thousands of kids and families who walk through our doors every week. If all this sounds good, keep reading.

WHAT'S THE PROCESS?

Attend Kids' Club 101.

This is the first step for new volunteers and meets at each site. Here, you'll get an overview of what goes on in Kids' Club. (Not required for weekday volunteers.)

We'll process your application.

Once you've submitted this application, our onboarding staff will process your background check, contact your references and keep you updated on the progress.

Invite a friend.

Observe and join a team with a friend. This helps make the process more fun and more comfortable for both of you. This isn't required, but let us know if a friend will join you.

Observe.

We'll contact you to observe in a specific area. You'll serve alongside experienced volunteers who will show you the ropes. You can check out several areas until you find the best fit for you. *You may begin observing before your application is fully processed, but please know, if you sign up to observe, we are counting on you. So please show up.*

Join a team.

After your application has been processed, you will select a team. At this time, you'll be given instructions and guidelines specific to your team.

WHAT AM I COMMITTING TO?


- **Time commitment** varies depending on the serving role you choose.
- We ask that all volunteers commit to serving at least twice per month. It does you and your team good, but you're free to control your own schedule.
- Volunteers in 3rd through 5th grade must be willing to serve three out of four weekends—it's important for making connections with kids. **For weekend roles, volunteers arrive in their serving area/room 25 minutes before the service starts.** Also, all volunteers should attend a service in the auditorium. Serving should not take the place of a weekend service but be in addition to it.

WHAT ABOUT MY OWN KIDS?

Children two years old and younger can stay in their Kids' Club room for two services on the weekends while you are serving.

Children three years old (and potty trained) through 5th grade can go to Adventure Club for one of the services they attend. Adventure Club is for kids of parents who are serving on that weekend and who will be at Crossroads for two services. Adventure Club is offered at different services, depending on the Crossroads site you attend. Check with your site for details.

Childcare for infants through 5th graders is provided for volunteers serving on some weekday mornings. Check with your site for availability.



CAN STUDENTS VOLUNTEER?

Realizing that there are other great opportunities for growth at Crossroads, we require that all student volunteers also attend their Kids' Club class or services at Crossroads in addition to serving. Student volunteers who are 10 years old* or older can serve in the following age groups:

- 10 to 12-year-olds* can serve with 2-year-olds through Preschool.
(Must serve with parent or guardian.)
- 13 to 15-year-olds can serve with 1-year-olds through 2nd Grade.
- 16 to 17-year-olds can serve with 1-year-olds through 5th Grade.
(Must be at least four grade levels beyond the age group with which they are serving.)
- Must be at least 18 years old to serve with children under the age of one.

**To ensure that our youngest volunteers get the coaching and encouragement they need, students 10–12 years old must serve alongside a parent or guardian.*
