WHERE TO FIND IT

schedule

Please follow this adapted schedule:

- Connect Time (15 minutes): Start 5 minutes after service starts
- Large Group Part 1 (10 minutes): Begin 25 minutes after service start time
- Group Activity (15 minutes): In the Large Group script section
- Large Group Part 2 (15 minutes)
- Small Group (10 minutes)
- Extra Activities (keep kids engaged until parents arrive)

LESSON TITLE

We can trust God.

MAIN POINT

tips

Be sure to start Connect Time 5 minutes after the service start time. And if it doesn't happen because the beginning of service is hectic, cut Connect Time short. Whatever you do, be sure to start the first Large Group video 25 minutes after the service start time.

check-in/out

As kids leave, make sure they get part of the wall!

large group heads up

Today is all about Joshua and trusting God. Read Joshua 1-6 the week before the service and ask God to help you talk about Joshua and trust with kids.

CONNECT to time

connect time

GOAL: Connect Time is all about engaging kids in an activity that allows them to connect with each other right away while simultaneously piquing their curiosity for Large Group and preparing their minds for what they're going to hear.

BACKWARDS TRUST WALK

- Put kids in pairs.
- Line them up against one wall in the room.
- Pull some **chairs** and **various objects** into the middle of the room to create an obstacle course.
 - *Make this as simple or difficult as you prefer for your group.
- Then have one partner in each pair turn around to directly face the wall.
- The forward (non-wall)-facing kid has to lead his/her partner walk backwards to the opposite wall without running into any of the obstacles, bumping into other kids or turning around and walking forwards. If they do any of those things, the pair must start over.
 - *Feel free to let younger groups walk forwards if that seems best.
- Once all pairs have made it, start over (but rearrange the objects in the middle) so that both partners experience what it's like to walk backwards.

TALK ABOUT IT

- · How did it feel to not know where you were going?
- Did trusting your friend make it easier?

Before you go to Large Group, you can also remind kids of the expectations for Large Group behavior: (1) be kind, (2) listen when somebody speaks, and (3) follow the leader's instructions.



instructions

Goal: Kids will (1) recognize that Joshua trusted God, (2) understand why we can trust God, and (3) identify one way they will trust God this week.

Why? There are so many places in the Bible where God shows us that he wants our trust.

Tip: At the end, keep kids engaged in the "extra time" activities until their parents arrive.

small group

SMALL GROUPS

- 1. (**image of giant walls**) When did Joshua trust God? (when he wasn't scared off by the big scary giants; when he faced the huge wall full of people ready to fight)
- 2. (**image of Red Sea**) How did Joshua trust God? (he remembered what God had done, like made a path right through the middle of the Red Sea, showed them where to go with a pillar of fire at night and a cloud during the day, gave them water from rocks and sent food like rain every morning, promised to bring them to Canaan; he also obeyed, which showed his trust)
- 3. (hold up verse card) Why did Joshua trust God? (because God promised to be with him and he knew God is more powerful than anything)
- 4. How can we trust God?

MAKE IT PERSONAL

- Give each kid a piece of paper from the wall *puzzle pack* (key included)
- On it, have them write/draw one hard thing they're facing. It might be something they worry about or something difficult they know they'll have to do.
- Then put the puzzle together. Have kids construct it on the floor or tape it to the wall, whichever is best for your group.

*Pray with kids, asking for delivery. You can even say together, "I trust you, God!"

Then tear the wall down. Have fun with this!

REMEMBER TO TRUST

Kids can take their own torn pieces if they want. You can also give them a *wall coloring page* with the verse on it. Let kids color it and remind them to hang it up somewhere in their house and trust God this week! If you have extra time, continue on the following page:



Extra Time? Do another obstacle course. Or play a group game of Simon Says or Musical Chairs!



special notes

It's going to be far easier to do the mid-Large Group game in small groups than in one whole group. Split into small groups after Video 1.

presenter tips

No one person will have to lead the whole group. But choose one adult to introduce both videos briefly (script provided below) and to tell groups when to be back for Video 2 (no later than 50 minutes after the service start time).

script

*Click to play intro music

START 25 MINUTES AFTER SERVICE BEGINS

*Choose one adult to come onto the presentation area and briefly announce the video:

This weekend, we have a special video host who's going to talk to us about trusting God.

Video: Large Group Video 1 (about 10 min.)

Now let's split into small groups and play a game. We'll come back (set the time; no later than 50 minutes after the service start time—earlier if you want). When it's time to return, I'll (flicker the lights, play the intro music, etc. Choose an easy way to notify groups that it's time to return.)

BACK-TO-BACK DRAWINGS

*Play as small groups.

- Give each kid a **blank piece of paper** and a **marker**. Have them set it horizontally in front of them (landscape layout).
- Draw a line down the middle of from top to bottom. Do this on the other side, too. There are now spots for kids to draw 4 different images.
- Tell kids they are going draw a special picture, but they won't know what it is until they obey all your instructions.
- Here are the images and ideas on how to instruct kids. Feel free to be creative. The main idea is that they don't know what they're drawing until they've obeyed you. For younger kids, draw step by step *with* them to model the image.
 - **House**: Draw a square. Draw a triangle on top of the square. Draw two little squares floating in the middle of the square. At the bottom of the square, draw a tall rectangle.



script continued

- **Flower**: Draw a circle. Draw a line coming straight down from the circle. Now draw five circles around the one in the middle.
- Chocolate chip cookie: Draw a big circle. In the middle, draw lots of little circles.
- **Top hat**: Draw a short and long rectangle at the bottom of your drawing area. On top of it, right in the middle, draw a square that's very tall but not as long as the rectangle.

TALK ABOUT IT

- Did you know what you were drawing at first? How did you figure it out?
- In real life, do you always know what God has coming next?
- · What can you do to trust God in those situations?

NO LATER THAN 50 MINUTES AFTER THE SERVICE START TIME, RETURN TO THE LARGE GROUP AREA:

Our host for today is back! She's going to tell us more about Joshua's story.


