WHERE TO FIND IT

Jesus at the Temple

LESSON TITLE

Jesus spends time with God.

MAIN POINT

schedule

First 10 minutes of the service hour: Engage kids in cooperative play activities to help them connect to other kids

Next 5 minutes: Connect Time

Next 25 minutes: Large Group

Last 25 minutes: Snack and Small

Group

tips

Sometimes it's easy to think of misbehaving kids as a "distraction," but try to think of it as an opportunity to connect instead! Try to spend some one-on-one time with them, and make them feel welcome and loved, no matter what.

check-in/out

As kids leave, ask them about their Jesus image, and how they "found" him today!

large group heads up

We don't know a whole lot about Jesus' childhood. But today, we're learning the one story we have about his life as a kid. It's the story of how Mary and Joseph accidentally left Jesus at the temple for three days. When they found him, he wasn't even scared. He was enjoying spending time with God!





connect time

GOAL: Connect time is all about engaging kids in a short, interactive game to prepare them for Large Group.

- Clean up! (10 minutes after the service start time, when you get the 5-minute warning from the presenter)
- Line Up
- While in line, tell kids that we're going to talk about what Jesus was like as a kid. To help them relate to Jesus, tell them that:
 - Jesus had to grow up: pretend to be small/short and stretch up tall.
 - Jesus had to eat food: pretend to eat or have kids shout out their favorite foods
 - Jesus played with his friends: high five each other.
 - Jesus had to get stronger: flex your muscles.
 - Jesus probably got bug bites or itchy skin: scratch your arm/hand.
 - o Jesus had to take baths: hold your nose and pretend to be underwater.
 - Jesus had to breathe: take deep breaths.
 - Jesus probably yawned: yawn.
 - Jesus had to sleep: pretend to be asleep.

As you walk into Large Group, encourage kids to put on their listening ears! Remind them that HOPS will be showing us how we should act in Large Group, so we have to listen!





instructions

Goal: Kids will (1) understand why Jesus was at the temple even though he was just a kid, and (2) identify ways that we can spend time with God!

Why? This is the only story in the Bible describing Jesus as a kid, so we can assume it's pretty important!

Tip: You can have kids do the "searching" activity one at a time, or have a few do it at the same time, in multiple bins. Do what works best for you!

small group

REVIEW THE STORY

- 1. What did Jesus do with his family? (Took a trip.)
- 2. When Joseph and Mary left to go back home, who did they forget? (Jesus!)
- 3. Where did Mary and Joseph find Jesus? (In the temple/church.)
- 4. What was Jesus doing there? (Spending time with God.)
- 5. Where can WE spend time with God? (Anywhere! Then list a couple specific places and ask if we can spend time with God there, like home, school, the playground, the zoo, the grocery store, etc. The answer is always YES!)
- 6. What can we do when we spend time with Jesus? (Talk to him, worship him with songs and dancing, listen to him, read the Bible, go outside and see the things he created, come to Kids' Club...anything!)

MAKE IT PERSONAL

- Put an empty bin on each table and fill it with 10 streamers (tear off 1-foot long sections from the roll) and 20 quarter-sheets of paper.
- Disperse the **Jesus images** in the box of materials and mix them up (Make sure there's enough Jesus images for each kid, in each bin.)
- Hold up a Jesus image for all the kids to see, and tell them that he's "lost," just like in today's story! Let each kid have a turn sorting through the materials in the bins until they find a Jesus image for themselves. (If they're younger and need help, you might want to pull the image out yourself and ask: "Is this Jesus? Yay, we found him!") Then let kids color their image with *markers*.
- Once all kids get a chance to "find" Jesus, ask them questions to remind them that Jesus wasn't really lost, he was spending time with God!
 - When Mary and Joseph lost Jesus, where was he? (The temple/church.)
 - What was Jesus doing there? (Spending time with God.)

Extra time? Have kids do a **coloring sheet**. After that, let them play hide and seek with their Jesus images, hiding them around the room for others to find!

special notes

Have fun acting out the different parts of this story with kids, and if you want to spend extra time acting like you're riding on donkeys, or traveling to Jerusalem, then go for it!

presenter tips

script

WELCOME AND INTRO

Main Goal: Review the beginning of God's story and rescue plan.

Notes:

- *Click to play intro music.
- Video: HOPS Have fun!
- Say: (Holding up the *Bible*.) This is God's story. Out of all
 the stories in the world, this is the most important. Do you
 know what it's called? (Let kids respond "the Bible.") That's
 right, the Bible! It's God's Rescue plan. It shows us how He
 rescued us from all the wrong things in the world.
- Say: In the beginning, God made the whole world and everything in it. He created the sun and the moon, the water and the land, the plants and the animals, and people like you and me! Everything was good. Give me a big thumbs up! (Let kids respond. Then change your tone.)
- Say: But THEN, something bad happened. Adam and Eve disobeyed God, and all the wrong things came into the world. Things like sadness and death. Show me your sad face. (Let kids respond.)
- Say: Even though Adam and Eve disobeyed God, God loved them anyway! He planned a great rescue so that Adam and Eve, and you and me, could be close to God again! Do you know who the Rescuer is? (Let kids say: Jesus!)



JESUS WAS A KID

Main Goal: Understand that Jesus grew up just like us!

JESUS TAKES A TRIP

Main Goal: Understand why Jesus and his family took a trip to Jerusalem.

- **Say:** Today, we're going to hear a story about Jesus when he was a kid like you! Do you guys know that Jesus grew up just like *you're* growing up? (Let kids respond.)
- Say: He did all sorts of things, like play with toys and eat his dinner, and he probably even got "ouchies" sometimes when he fell down! Point to one place YOU'VE gotten an "ouchie." (Let kids point.) Jesus knows what that feels like!
- **Say:** Well, another thing Jesus did was take a trip with his family. Have any of you guys taken a trip with your family before? (Let kids respond.)
- (Image: Suitcase) Jesus probably packed a bag for his trip. So let's see...What do you think Jesus packed? (Let kids respond.) Good answers! Maybe he packed....
- (Image: Toothbrush) A toothbrush!
- (Image: Clothes) I bet he brought some extra clothes!
- (Image: Snacks) How about snacks, do you think he needed those too? (Let kids respond.) Sure!
- Say: When everything was ready, Jesus and his parents, Mary and Joseph, got ready to leave with their cousins and friends.
- **Say:** Let's pretend we're traveling with them. Stand up and walk in place. (Respond along with kids.) There were no cars or airplanes, so they might have walked or ridden on donkeys or camels.
- (Image: Jesus and the donkey) Let's pretend we're riding a donkey. Ready? (Trot in place along with kids.)
- Say: Let's think about how it sounded as they traveled.
 What noise does a donkey make? (Let kids respond.)
 That's right, hee-haw! Let's make that sound as we go.
 (Trot and hee-haw to model for the kids. You can stay in place, or let kids move around a bit, whichever works best for your group.)

JESUS GETS LOST

Main Goal: See how Mary and Joseph got very worried when they lost Jesus!

- (Image: Jerusalem city) Finally, they arrived at a big city, so you guys can have a seat now. The city was called Jerusalem. Can you guys say Jerusalem? (Let kids say: Jerusalem.)
- Say: Jesus and his family had a great time in Jerusalem, but when Mary and Joseph got ready to leave, they didn't notice that Jesus was missing...so they left him in Jerusalem! Say, "Oh no!" (Let kids respond.)



MARY AND JOSEPH SEARCH

Main Goal: Understand how worried Mary and Joseph felt.

JESUS IS FOUND

Main Goal: Understand that Jesus was at the temple spending time with God, and we can spend time with him too!

WRAP UP AND WORSHIP

Main Goal: Help kids interact through prayer and worship!

- Say: After a WHOLE day of traveling back home, Mary and Joseph realized that Jesus wasn't there! (Act really surprised and worried.) They went back to find him, but they had to search for Jesus for THREE whole days! Let's count to three on our fingers right now. (Count along with kids.)
- Say: They looked everywhere, but they still couldn't find Jesus! Say, "Oh no!" (Let kids respond.) They were so worried.
- (Image: Jesus at the temple) Finally, they found him. Whew! Jesus was at a temple, which is like a church. Jesus hadn't even been scared to be away from his parents, because he had been spending time with God! Do you think it's a good idea to spend time with God? (Let kids respond.) Me too. Let's all give a thumbs up! (Let kids respond.)
- **Say:** Guess what? We can spend time with God, too! We don't have to be at church to spend time with God. We can talk to him at home, at the playground, at the zoo—anywhere! God loves it when we spend time with him.
- **Say:** Let's spend time with God right now, just like Jesus did, by praying.
- Pray (Breaking it into small, repeatable phrases): Hi
 God! Thanks for sending Jesus. Help us to spend time with
 you, just like Jesus did. We love you! A-MEN.
- Set up worship: There's another great way to spend time with Jesus-worshipping him with singing and dancing! Let's all stand up and worship him together.
- Music Video: Come With MeMusic Video: Deep and Wide
- Song: King of the Jungle




